## READINGS: 28 January '18 - Year B

**1st Reading:** *Dt 18:15-20 In today's passage, Moses reveals that, after his death, God will raise up from among His people someone who will fulfill his role as prophet and mediator. Such a promise will be fulfilled in Jesus Christ.*

**2nd Reading:** *1 Cor 7:32-35 Here is a simple presentation of St. Paul's reflection on the proper attitude of a Christian concerning the two basic states of life: married life and virginity.*

**Gospel:** *Mk 1:21-28 Today's Gospel passage portrays Jesus in action in the village of Capernaum. He teaches with authority and acts with power by setting a man free from the devil's influence.*
