PARISH PASTORAL COUNCIL & FINANCE COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP UPDATE

At Sacred Heart Parish, we are blessed to have two important advisory groups that support our mission and administration: the **Parish Pastoral Council (PPC)** and the **Finance Committee (FC)**.

According to our Parish and Diocesan Statutes, members may serve a maximum of **three years** on the PPC and **two years** on the FC. At this time, several members have graciously continued their service beyond these terms. In the spirit of renewal encouraged by the Statutes, **positions held by members who have exceeded their term limits will now be considered vacant**. New appointments will be made by **Monday 3rd November, and, following a transition period, appointees will commence their duties on Tuesday 25th November**, in preparation for the new Church year.

We warmly invite interested parishioners to consider serving on either the PPC or FC. **Current members are welcome to reapply**, and all expressions of interest will be thoughtfully and prayerfully considered. As always, **Fr. Hermie will discern and make the final decisions** regarding committee membership.

If you'd like to learn more about what serving on a committee involves, feel free to speak with one of the current members listed below. Statutes for the FC and PC are available at the office to view the duties and limits of these committees. If you feel called to serve, please let **Fr. Hermie** know as soon as possible.
